Christmas will be here before we know it! CCCC’s Christmas Choir rehearsals meet on Wednesdays at 7:00pm. We would love to have you join us!



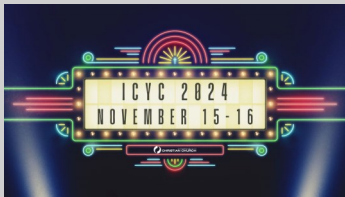
