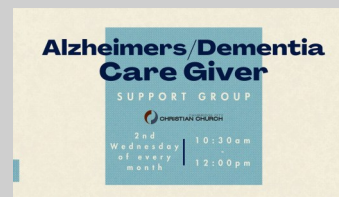
There will be a callout meeting for students grades 6-12 and their parents immediately following worship service on Sunday, February 23rd in the youth room. Lunch will be provided.

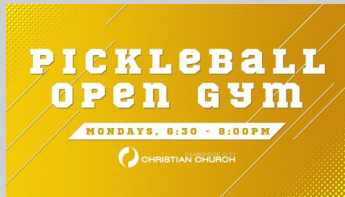
