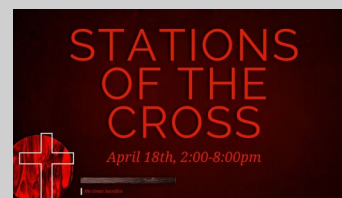
# COMING UP..
